Peer Review

To ensure impartial and rigorous critical feedback, we adopt an anonymous two-stage peer review approach: a training video script review and a training package review. The reviews are carried out by experts in the field, often a leading charity or association.

Training video script review is a key quality assurance step in our development process. It ensures that the audio-visual element of the package contains no technical inaccuracies. Reviewers focus on the appropriateness of the learning points, language used and shots suggested, ensuring they are entirely applicable for the care setting and the learning subject.

Training package review encompasses a review of all the elements that come together to form the training package, as follows:

- The final edit of the video is assessed to confirm that no errors or omissions inadvertently crept in during filming and editing.
- The lesson plan and supporting materials are reviewed to ensure that, within the training session, maximum use is made of the training film and key learning points are either developed further or re-enforced by way of relevant discussion topics, case studies, exercises and handouts.
